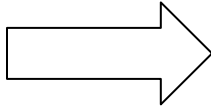

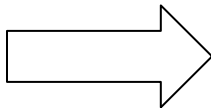

Infrastructure & Investment:



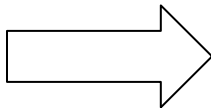
- ✗ Wind energy under pressure from public & opposition group
- ✗ Negative impacts on hydro rates impacting all consumers & manufacturing competitiveness

Local Economic Benefits:



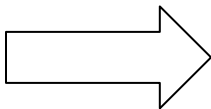
- ✗ Come with risk to human health
- ✗ Come with loss of residential, business & tourism opportunities
- ✗ Future of proposed residential developments in Dutton, Wallacetown & Iona
- ✗ Liability to DD for litigation, decommissioning
- ✗ Proposed tax assessment doesn't match GEA guidelines

Ultra-High Speed internet:



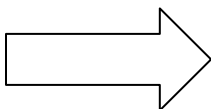
- ✗ Fibre optic cables won't improve service to community

Comprehensive Economic Benefit Agreement:



- ✗ Set-back proposals (with vs. without CEBA) more of a threat than a framework for a partnership

Unwilling Host Declaration?



- ✓ Council response should reflect community survey outcome
- ✓ Would reduce D/D liability if project moves ahead
