Named Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing


Don's experience will assist the municipality in guiding it through the wastewater upgrades, working with engineers and ensuring the necessary steps are taken through the process.

Dutton Flour Mill - Impact of doing business in the USA

Business arrangements from Dutton to Indiana Circa 1921.

Dutton's Connection to the corporate giant General Mills.

A story of economic expansion.



The Dutton Flour Mill was established in 1874 by Archibald McEachern on Lot 7 Main Street North opposite the Dutton Dunwich Public School.

In 1886 **Henry Hollingshead** from Galt a pioneer millwright moved to Dutton and purchased the mill from John Leitch and made many technological advancements including adding more capacity and an office. Later his son **William** in 1908 would take over the business. In 1921 William made a very important move for the milling company. He contracted with **Inglehart Bros. of Evansville Indiana** for milling of the very popular **Swan Down Flour**. A high-grade cake flour and special quality bran. Hollingshead cooperated with the MPP for Elgin F.S. Thomas, who was the agriculture representative, and got many farmers to grow the grade of winter and red wheat required for Swan Down Flour. Selling and doing business abroad is nothing new. Today many products move freely across borders creating opportunities for new markets and expanded capacity. Wealth was created in the Hollingshead family as a result of a decision William made in 1921.
