To: Employers in Elgin County, Oxford County, and the City of St. Thomas

Re: **Public health guidance and regulations related to the *Occupational Health and Safety* and the *Reopening Ontario Act***

Employers and workers in Ontario have certain duties and rights under the regional [Letter of Instruction for Face Coverings](#), and regulations under the *Occupational Health and Safety Act (OHSA)* and the [Reopening Ontario Act \(A Flexible Response to COVID-19\)](#).

Employers should review and follow any applicable directives and guidance within these regulatory documents.

It is important to also ensure businesses are following capacity regulations regarding the number of patrons allowed in an establishment at one time.
