Dear Mayor Purcell:

This is further to the correspondence of November 13, 2020, that Ms. Tara Kretschner, Archival/Records and Clerks Assistant of the Municipality of Dutton Dunwich, has addressed to the Honourable Jonathan Wilkinson, Minister of Environment and Climate Change and Minister responsible for Parks Canada, and to me, enclosing a Council resolution to replace the Historic Sites and Monuments Board of Canada (HSMBC) plaque commemorating Port Talbot National Historic Site. I am pleased to respond on behalf of both the Minister and Parks Canada.

The Minister designates places, persons and events of national historic significance on the recommendation of the HSMBC. Once a subject is designated for its national significance, the usual form of commemoration is a bronze plaque.

Parks Canada was notified in 2018 of the unfortunate theft of the plaque for Port Talbot National Historic Site. As a matter of policy, all plaque texts must be reviewed prior to replacement to ensure that they reflect contemporary knowledge. A significant amount of research by Parks Canada historians is required for the preparation of a revised plaque text. The Agency is aware of the importance of this plaque to your community and has tentatively scheduled this plaque for replacement in 2021.
